ALETRO MISSION

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To locate personal collections of aerospace technology documents and artifacts for the last half of the twentieth century and provide for the owners and heirs a service to digitize and preserve these collections in the public domain for use by future generations. To share this information through collaboration with industry, educational institutions, other nonprofits, and government organizations. *To inspire current and future generations of technologists through the “Old-Timers” (a vanishing resource) as docents providing the technological history of how aerospace challenges in the last half of the twentieth century were resolved.*

ALETRO VISION

Implement STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) lecture tours featuring aerospace “Old Timers” visiting science and technology museums and local schools motivating both university and K-12 students. Partner with both government and industry to provide presentation materials, including available hardware, and story-telling describing key technologies enabling aerospace development. Conduct oral history interviews during the STEM lecture tours with local “Old Timers” to expand the resources available to inspire students.
